(Gigantocypris) with eggs, Opisthoproctus soleatus (a remarkable little fish, with large telescopic eyes, caught once or twice




FIG. 73. Opisthoproctus grimaldii, Zugmayer. Nat. size, 2.6 cm.




Fig. 74.—Floating Long Lines. a, b, Big buoys; c, drift anchor; d, leather buoy.
