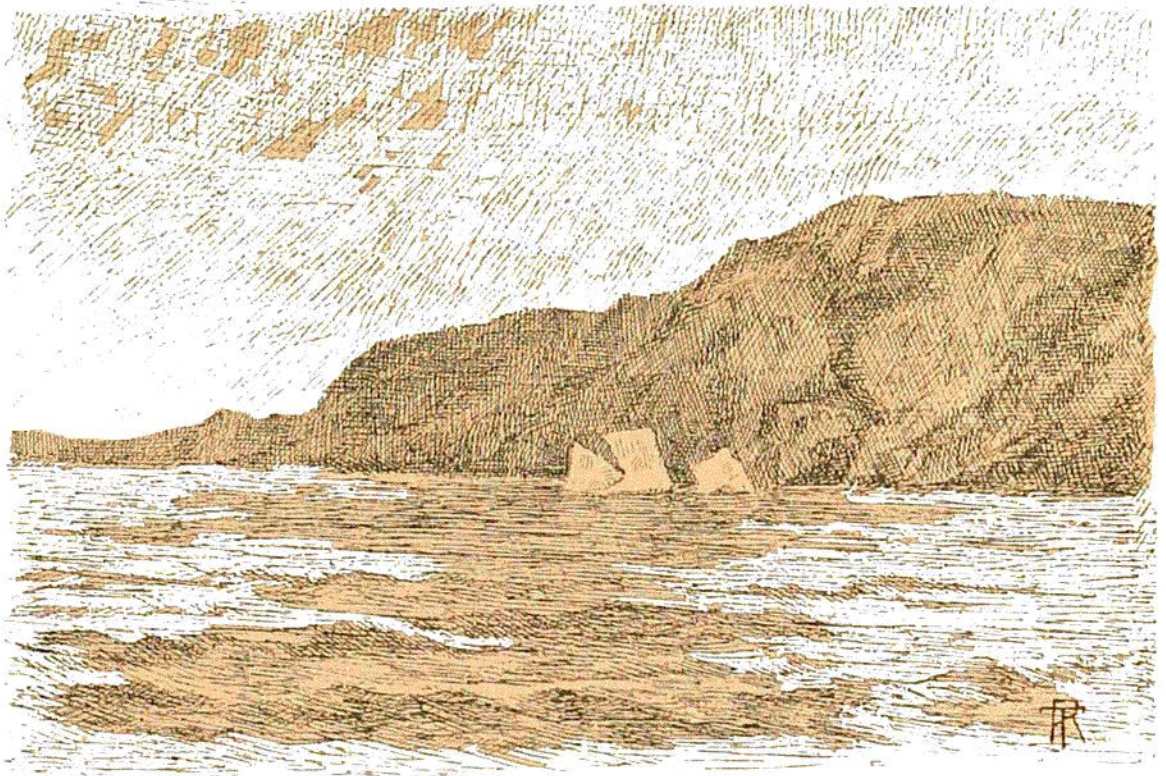


FIG. 100.—ICEBERGS OUTSIDE THE HARBOUR OF ST. JOHN'S.

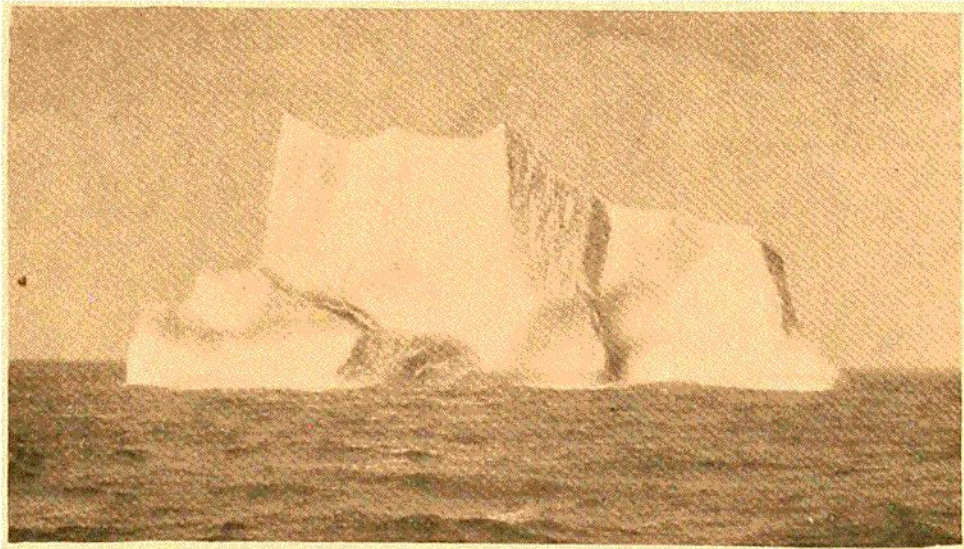


FIG. 101.—ICEBERG OUTSIDE ST. JOHN'S.



Atlantic (Figs. 100 and 101), and we had thus an ocular demonstration of the origin of the cold water on the Great Bank, as

well as of the dangers which the bank-fishers have to face. Icebergs, fog, and the great ocean-steamers are the chief perils
