

" larg






FIG. 522.—SPAWNING REGIONS OF THE THREE SPECIES OF THE GENUS MOLUA. Vertical lines, Molva byrkelange; horizontal lines and black portions, M. molva; dots, M. elongata. (From International Reports, vol. x.)
