Figure 1.—A portion of the rhizome and a frond of the ordinary form.

Figures 2 and 3.—Fronds of varieties of the same, figure 3 being bipinnatifid in the lower part.

Figure 4.—Portion of a pinnule, enlarged.

Figures 5 and 6.—Sporangia, much enlarged.
