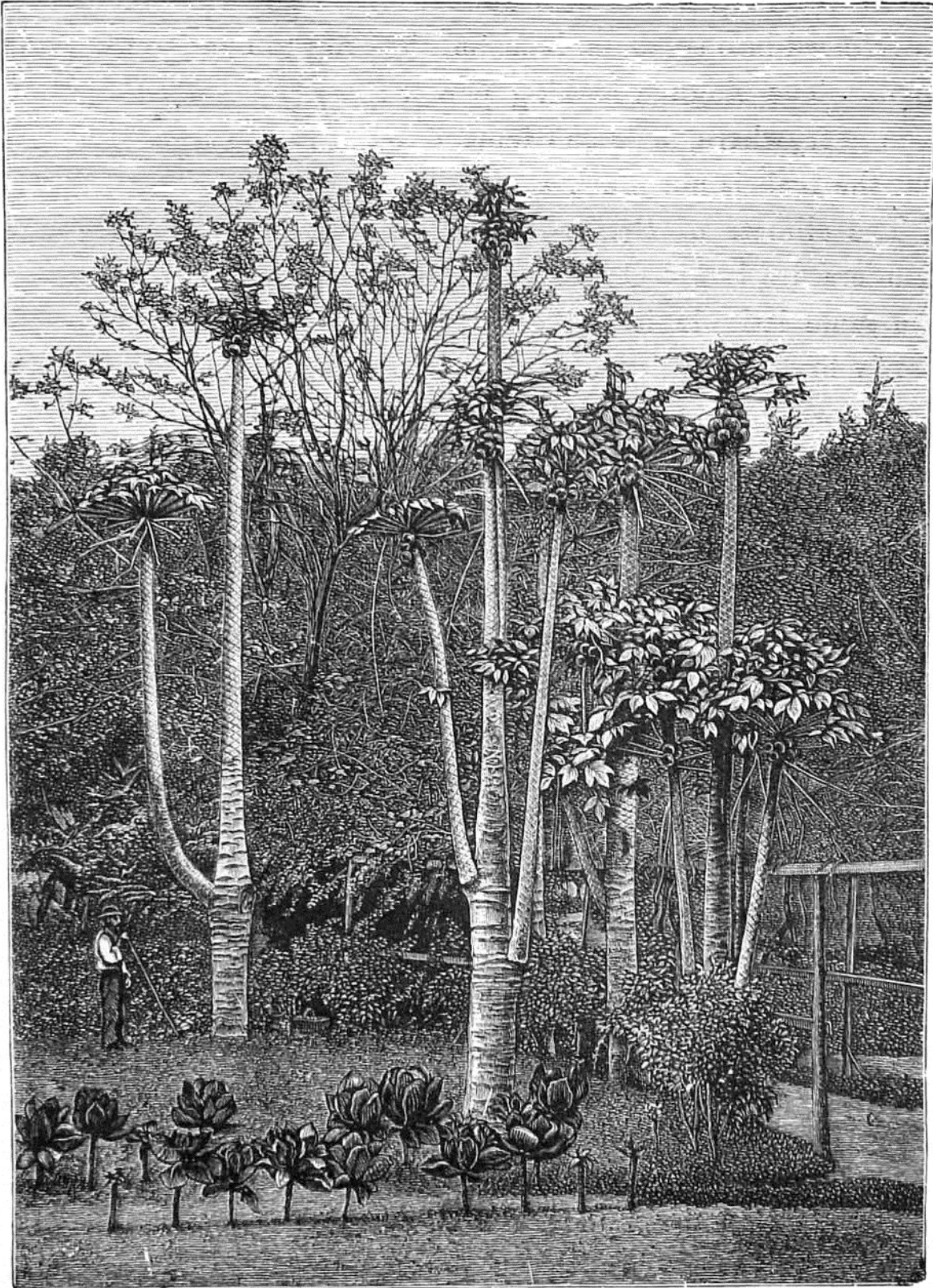


FIG. 87.—Papaw-trees (*Carica papaya*) in the Garden at Clarence Hill. (From a photograph.)
