

islands, penguins were to be seen in every direction. The birds were, *Diomedea exulans*, *D. fuliginosa*, *D. culminata*, a *Prion*, *Daption capensis*, *Ossifraga gigantea*, and an *Oceanitis*. A Skua also was seen, though the land was eight miles distant. A squall in the morning brought a slight fall of snow. The water assumed a peculiar dark colour, probably from its shallowness. Bligh's Cap is a small outlying rocky island to the north of Kerguelen's Land.

January 7th.—After lying off for the night we reached Christmas Harbour and anchored at 8.30 P.M.
